Dear Parents and Guardians,

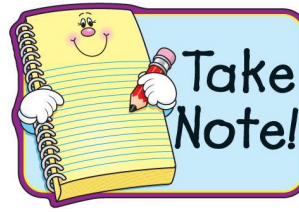

School Office - The school offices and doors will close at 3:00 this coming Wednesday for Thanksgiving Break and will reopen Monday morning, Nov. 29. Have a wonderful Thanksgiving.

SCRIP - Please consider using SCRIP for your shopping, gift card, and holiday needs. We have some cards on hand in the main office, and place orders every other week. We also encourage you to place online orders. We generally place orders a minimum of every two weeks, on a Monday morning.
